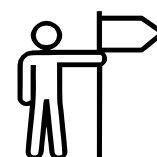
The IoCR maintains constant contact with leading and trusted providers of resilience solutions, technological and other, and assists its member organisations in finding the right solutions for their specific needs.

The IoCR supports all participants regardless of role or seniority, as part of our vision of change, driven by knowledge and awareness at all levels of the organisation.



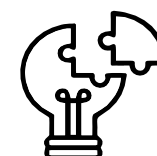
EDUCATION
